BRIEF SUMMARY OF PROBABLE CAUSE

On Sunday, December 6, 2020, I received information from BreAna Giles that Jack Sigler had been burglarizing homes of deceased subjects and was in possession of stolen property. Trooper Severson and I contacted Jack Sigler at his residence, 1040 S Crestline Dr, Waldport. Jack consented to us searching his living space which is in the detached garage. I observed a small room which appeared to be Jack's bedroom in the garage on the property. As I entered Jack's bedroom space I observed gold colored Chinese throwing stars on a shelf to my right as I faced Jack's sleeping area. I asked Jack to lift up his mattress and observed several samurai swords underneath the mattress and wood rail frame the mattress lays on. Trooper Severson called Detective Dorsey and advised her of our findings.

Detective Dorsey confirmed the resident, Ronald Remy, at 1680 S Crestline Dr #3, died on November 24, 2020. Detective Dorsey told me some time between Ronald's death, November 24, 2020 and December 1, 2020, his residence had been burglarized and samurai swords had been stolen. Detective Dorsey told me Ronald's landlord, Mark Campbell, secured Ronald's residence on December 1, 2020 after noticing the samurai swords missing.

Later, Detective Dorsey contacted Jack who provided more stolen property he stated he took from Ronald Remy's residence. Detective Dorsey told me Jack provided her with the following: (1) Calligraphy set in a black case, (1) black Dell Laptop 16" screen with a power cord with "Remy" label, (5) gold throwing stars, (40) \$1.00 gold color coins in black USA Sport bag, Jewelry including (16) rings, (1) necklace, (1) bracelet, cufflinks, (7) folding pocket knives, (2) silver metal throwing stars, (19) assorted watches in Footjoy black bag, (1) nun-chucks, (17) Assorted swords, Coin Collector Book with (12) coins, (1) red Makowsky purse with silver metal trim, totaling an estimated value over \$1500.00.

Detective Dorsey told me Patricia Campbell told her Jack confessed through Facebook Messenger that he burglarized Ronald Remy's house a total of three times, one time the first night and two times the second night. Detective Dorsey told me Patricia allowed her to take photographs of her and Jack's conversation. I reviewed the photographs of Patricia and Jack's conversation. I observed Jack message Patricia on Facebook Messenger on Sunday, December 6, 2020 around 1057 PM stating "Sorry....i messed up, but I didn't kill marc", "I wouldn't ever hurt anybody. A long day though, im home", "Im not in jail", "I didn't do it". I observed Patricia asked Jack, "I need to know did you do the breakin a few days earlier, the samurais"; I observed Jack replied, "Yes I did". I observed on Monday, December 7, 2020, Patricia asked Jack who he was with that night and Jack replied,

"Nobody...I went alone both nights." "2nd night I made two trips". I observed Patricia asked Jack what he meant by both nights and asked if Jack was there Sunday. I observed Jack replied "Noooo...not Sunday night!! Or Saturday or Friday", "Wed and Thursday I think..." "those nights I went" and later "I left the place neat. I didn't want anybody to notice for a while."

Eincoln City Detectives Lane and Burke contacted Sylvia Jones. Detectives advised Sylvia consented to them downloading her cell phone. I reviewed the download and observed on December 2020, Jack Sigler messaged Sylvia at 8:46 PM stating "We need to go on road trip on your next days off." At 8:47 PM Jack messaged Sylvia stating "Go over to Portland...hit all the pawn shops. I have over \$10,000, maybe way more than that, of stuff I need to get rid of". At 8:50 PM "Lots of gold, diamonds and samurai swords. 15 or so of them, all hand made. A sweet intel computer, and other shit. I'll kick you half of what we get rid of". At 8:51 PM "Cant be traced back either. Guy died and nobody even knew what was there. I'll tell you more later." At 8:52 PM Jack messaged Sylvia "Are you in?" I observed on December 5, 2020 starting at 3:15 AM Jack Sigler sent photographs to Sylvia of the swords and other stolen property he mentioned the day prior. On December 5, 2020 at 8:33 PM Jack Sigler messaged Sylvia "are we still on for Monday?" I reviewed the message log from October 31, 2020 at 6:03 PM through December 7, 2020, and observed Jack messaged Sylvia on December 4, 5, and 6th, 2020 during the timespan I reviewed on the download.
